# Send IT, ELR Shooting 2-Mile Challenge Series Finale and 2025 highlights

Send IT, ELR Shooting was established in 2019 to promote and grow Extreme Long Range (ELR) sports-shooting in South Africa. That now feels like a very long time ago, and as we reflect on our progress, it is important to understand where we all started.

Back then, modern propellants, as required for ELR calibres, had just landed in South Africa, and for the first time we were able to experiment with the big boomers. But credible technical information on large ELR calibres was difficult to come by, not to mention the lengthy (due to strict domestic firearm

regulations) and costly exercise to procure components from halfway across the world to build these firearms.

These headwinds had to be taken into consideration as ELR was therefore not accessible (and probably still not) to a broad range of shooters, requiring a substantial capital outlay to participate, and even harder to procure components. We knew it was going to be a multi-year process as shooters geared up to be competitive and become accustomed to ELR shooting. As a result, we started at more moderate ELR distances. The first Send IT ELR match was formulated around targets 1 km to 2 km that could be shot with what is now known as 'light' ELR rifles: think the fast 7 mms, 300s, and a couple of 338s. In fact, even some 6.5s showed up at the first match in 2019!

As time progressed, shooters got hooked on ELR shooting and the inevitable equipment upgrade cycle was in full swing. In 2022, it was notable that several shooters were geared to move beyond the 2 km mark.

That was the right time to introduce 2-Mile matches. In 2023, Send IT hosted the first 2-Mile match, later reconfigured into an annual series with a season finale in 2024 and 2025.

Over time, the dedicated 2-Mile range at Matroosbergstasie Shooting Range near De Doorns in the Western Cape was built with blood and sweat to what is now a glorious shooting venue with targets stacked all the way out to 4 000 m. Estian du Preez, owner of the land, and his team have been tremendous supporters of Send IT. We are thankful for all their hard work to transform barren land into a fabulous ELR range.

With three years of data available, a relatively short period, we can however highlight individual achievements at Send IT 2-Mile competitions. The table\* on the next page has the shooter's name and the number of impacts (from five shots) on the 2-Mile target at every Send IT 2-Mile match since 2023. It is important to note that the data is from a relatively small group of shooters, about 15 competitors per match, making the results even more impressive.

We can make interesting observations from the data. Out of 13 matches, there was only one competition where the 2-Mile target was not hit. That was 29 July 2023, when we literally shot in snow and rain and experienced the worst shooting conditions ever with zero feedback to adjust follow-up shots. Furthermore, 20 shooters have been able to make impact at 2-Miles, representing the lion's share of shooters who have attended Send IT 2-Mile competitions to date. Three shooters (Charl Gous, Edgar Doubell, and Pieter Eksteen) have been able to hit the target with three of their allowed five shots. Several shooters achieved two hits in a match. Lastly, James Preyser and Loutjie Hanekom have each been able to make impact at 2-Miles in four different matches, making them the most consistent in hitting the target.

## Send IT ULTRA

We cannot look back at 2025 without mentioning the Send IT ULTRA, our flagship annual event held at Karoo King of the Plains Shooting Range near Hanover in the Northern Cape. The Send IT ULTRA format is unique in that shooters engage multiple targets across six ranges with a high round

count over several days. Targets were set 900 m to 2 201 m. On each range, match participants fired three shots at each target for a total of nine shots per range, before handing over to his or her shooting partner and spotter to complete the course of fire with another nine shots at the same targets.

**Importantly, at the Send IT ULTRA, shooters get tested throughout the day, over multiple days, and not in a particular time slot that might or might not present favourable shooting conditions. Once completed, and after firing 81 shots over three days, the most consistent shooters rise to the top of the score board.**

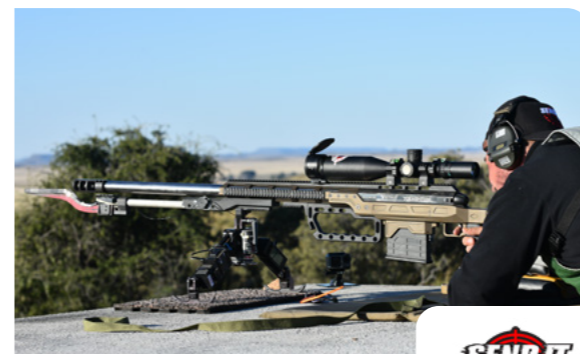
## Number of impacts achieved at 2-Miles since 2023

And consistency was exactly what first-placed individual Warwick du Preez (375 CT) brought to the table, with an incredible 77% hit rate. It was visible how proud Warwick was about his achievement as well as his determination and focus to perform well among his fellow shooters. A fantastic performance and an incredible win! It is emotional moments like these that make us proud to host events where we can witness the joy of many years of hard work paying off. In addition, Warwick's teammate Ivan Fourie (33 XC) was in superb form, securing second place with a 73% hit rate. Thys de Beer (300 Norma SMF), with a 69% hit rate, had to settle for a well-deserved bronze medal. Unsurprisingly, the teams category was won by The Bomb Squad (Ivan Fourie and Warwick du Preez; 77% hit ratio) by a comfortable margin. It was great to see the Impact Xtreme 1 (Shaun Flink and Thys de Beer; 64% hit rate) team

# Send IT 2-Mile Challenge Series Finale 2025

The series comprised *four* 2-Mile Challenge qualifying matches, from which an individual shooter's two best scores were used to calculate a year-to-date ranking table. At the qualifying matches, the range was

made up of five preselected targets for a total of 25 shots (five per target). The table below highlights the individuals who finished in the top three positions at each of the four qualifying matches and the final, their

hit percentage, and those shooters who hit the 2-Mile target. The January and March matches were shot in good weather, as reflected by the comparatively high hit percentages achieved.

Heading into the final, the top three shooters (Pieter Eksteen, Izak Hanekom, and Deon Fabel) were separated by a mere 4 000 points. Unfortunately, Izak had to withdraw at the last minute. Given his excellent form, it would have been great to see him compete in the final. It is interesting to note that the winner of the final did not feature in the top five in the year-to-date ranking table prior to the match. To put the point difference into perspective: 4 000 points can be accumulated with two successful impacts given the extreme distances shot at and the multipliers applied to the scoring formula.

## Match Results

Eight targets from 1 996 m to 3 249 m glimmered in the sun as the match promptly kicked off at 07:00. The shooters got off to a fair start at the 2 655 m (2 904 yd) target, with a couple of hits, but largely struggled to score on the 3 246 m (3 550 yd) and 2 980 m (3 259 yd) targets. Loutjie Hanekom and Deon Fabel hit the 2-Mile target; Deon followed up with two hits on the 2 980 m (3 259 yd) target. Ivan Fourie also made a good start, with two hits on the 2 655 m (2 904 yd) target and two on the 2 980 m (3 259 yd) plate. Fifteen shots into a forty-shot match and the scores were low, with only a handful of standout performances. Plenty of points were still on offer as

we moved to the closer targets, but the conditions were difficult due to a severe mirage and a howling, full-on wind. It was interesting to note that by this stage Danie du Preez (416 Hellfire) had scored no points. However, Danie hit a purple patch with 14 out of 25 hits on the remaining five targets to secure the win on the day! Second was Charl Gous (416 Hellfire), followed by Ivan Fourie (375 CT) in third. Pieter Eksteen, year-to-date leader before the final, was having an uncharacteristically tough day, opening the door for those lower ranked to advance up the ranking table. We got the sense that it was going to be a tight result in respect of the series top three, but never thought it would be as close as it ended up being.
