Send IT's 16th ELR match at Darling Steel Valley, Darling, Western Cape was on 28 September 2024. The inaugural event was held on a cold, wet and windy 6 July 2019. Overlooking Table Mountain, the range is at sea level next to the West Coast, an hour's drive from Cape Town. The range is well known for tricky wind conditions and horseshoe topography where shooters regularly need to contend with aggressive fishtail winds.

The weekend's weather report was closely watched as a severe cold front was expected to disrupt what was supposed to be a sunny spring day in South Africa. We are familiar with this match venue's testing wind conditions but shooting in the rain is never pleasant.

Match day

The match kicked off promptly at 08:00. Shooters had to contend with a firm 9 'o clock full on wind varying 14 mph to 18 mph. As the day progressed the wind picked up and became even fiercer, with speeds up to 30 mph, holding at 9 'o clock. Thankfully it was a dry match with only a sprinkle of rain towards the end of the day.

To provide perspective, misjudging the wind speed of a full value wind by 2 mph (when shooting in winds of 20 mph or more) will result in a miss when engaging 2 MOA targets at distances of more than 1.3 km. Several shooters reportedly did not have enough windage dial in their rifle scopes and had to holdover well beyond the targets to curve their bullets towards their intended destination.

The margin of error was thin as even a small gust of wind pushed bullets off target just to over correct on the next shot as the gust calms down. The landscape and terrain were also tricky to master. From early in the day shooters reported missed shots that were very high relative to the output of their ballistic solvers. This was not isolated to a few but across the field

shooters had to come down relative to their calculated elevation setting. It was a new phenomenon at this shooting venue, where we have never experienced shots high by up to 3.5 MOA or 1 mil relative to the predicted result. Shooters quickly worked out the adjustments needed but were left puzzled and questioning why it was happening. Was it the overcast conditions? Was it the hilly environment with winds pushing up into the mountain towards the targets? These questions remain unanswered as we traverse the unknowns of ELR shooting.

Carlo produced an excellent performance on the far targets with three out of three hits on the 1 651 m (1806 yd) Target, two out of three hits on the 1754 m (1918 yd) target and three out of three hits on the 1857 m (2 031 yd) target.

I am unashamedly biased and very proud of his achievement. Carlo approached every shot with great confidence, focus, and intense concentration. On the final round of the day (Carlo's shooting group ended on Range 2), knowing he was having a good round, he delivered six out of seven hits in extremely difficult conditions to secure the gold medal (unknow to him at the time).

Hot on is heels was Dwayne Cronje, using a custom built 37 XC, also achieving a 71% hit rate for a points total of 37 657 and silver. Pieter Eksteen (300 Norma Magnum Improved), a familiar podium contender, secured bronze with a 68% hit rate. The top three individual shooters produced stellar results! Team Sonic (Carlo and Charl Gous) took first place team, followed by 3% Tactical (Ivan Fourie
